Even Cleansed Rue, who used to be a Tier 5 Divine Mage, could not release her Mana Domain in an environment with such powerful mental oppression. Yet, not only did Gentle Snow manage to use her Mana Domain, but she had also managed to execute Space Freezing with it.

This had already gone beyond surprising and reached the realm of fantasy!

It should be known that Space Freezing was an advanced method of using a Mana Domain, and it was impossible to execute without profound knowledge of Mana. The technique was so complex that only a small minority of Tier 5 magical class experts could execute it. Yet, Gentle Snow had successfully used Space Freezing despite being a Berserker.

"Let's join in as well. She won't be able to handle so many Gargoyle Guards by herself," Shi Feng said when he saw that Hundred Flower Palace's members remained in a daze. "I'll distract the Gargoyles while the rest of you focus them down."

The Gargoyle Guards might have had their combat standards reduced to the Trial Tower's fifth-floor standard, but they were still Level 110 Grand Lords. A group of more than a hundred Gargoyle Guards

Before a God's Domain gained access to the Greater God's Domain, it would typically categorize its experts based on the Realms of Refinement.

However, in the Greater God's Domain, there was only one publicly acknowledged categorization for strength—the World Tower.

The World Tower was similar to the Trial Tower available in every God's Domain, and all players in the Greater God's Domain ranked their strengths based on their performance in the World Tower.

However, compared to the Trial Tower, the World Tower's difficulty was significantly greater. So long as players managed to clear the World Tower's first floor, they would be publicly recognized as experts in the Greater God's Domain. After all, besides having sufficiently high combat standards, players would also need to have sufficient fortuitous opportunities to get promoted to Tier 6.

The current Hundred Flower Palace's Crimson Heart could just barely be considered a third-floor expert. Everyone in the Tower Alliance's party was similarly at this standard. Unfortunately, they were all stuck at the cusp of reaching Tier 6.

As for experts capable of clearing the World Tower's fourth floor, these were existences capable of ranking within the top ten in their God's Domain. Even the Tower Alliance only had one such player in its midst.

It should be known that the difficulty of the World Tower's third and fourth floors was worlds apart from each other. The fourth floor's challenge was so difficult that every one of their God's Domain's current fourth-floor experts had only managed to clear the fourth floor after gaining access to the Greater God's Domain and sparring numerous times with the God-ranked experts there.

"The Stratified Abyssal Realm is the gathering place for the various God's Domains' newbies. Setting aside the native players, the strongest players there are third-floor experts like us. There is no way any power would send a fourth-floor expert there. If we can get a fourth-floor expert's help, we'll have a much easier time establishing a foothold in the Stratified Abyssal Realm."

The Stratified Abyssal Realm might be a gathering place for the various God's Domains' newbies, but it was also a place highly contested by the powers of the various God's Domains. This was because aside from being rich in rare resources such as the Seven Luminaries Crystal, the Stratified Abyssal Realm was also home to many players with superior talent.

Due to the Stratified Abyssal Realm's nature, many of its native players grew faster than players based in normal God's Domains. Their chances of becoming second-floor and third-floor experts were also several times higher. Occasionally, fourth-floor experts would even appear in the Stratified Abyssal Realm. Meanwhile, these experts had become a resource fought over by the Greater God's Domain's various powers.

"But this is a chance for us," Maria suddenly said, her eyes glowing with excitement as she looked at the two Dark Titans.

Currently, neither of their parties could go up against the Dark Titan on their own. They could only get past this Guardian Boss if their parties worked together.

"Indeed. They'll have no choice but to cooperate with us now," Blood Hammer said, smiling.

However, going against Maria and Blood Hammer's expectations, Shi Feng had long since expected such a development. As soon as the Dark Titan used Dark Division, he promptly activated the Winter of Eternal Night's World of Frost.

Immediately, nine frost swords appeared around the two Dark Titans, each frost sword carrying 120% of Shi Feng's Strength. Although the Sealing Labyrinth's mental oppression prevented Shi Feng from displaying his full potential, he still managed to manipulate the nine frost swords to the point where every frost sword could execute a basic combat technique. Upon hearing the system announcements, Crimson Heart and the other Hundred Flower Palace members couldn't help but grow ecstatic.

"We did it! Big Sis Rue!" Rain Song cheered while shaking Cleansed Rue by the shoulders. "Our party will get to monopolize 90% of the entry slots now!"

The Dark Titan might not have battle recovery, but raiding it was still a great challenge. Had the raid continued for ten more minutes, most of them would have collapsed from Stamina and Concentration exhaustion.

Fortunately, the Dark Titan's HP ran out before they collapsed from exhaustion.

"You made a huge contribution to the Guild this time, Rue. If not for you, we would've lost out on this huge opportunity," Crimson Heart said as she looked at Cleansed Rue

If not for Cleansed Rue strongly recommending Hundred Flower Palace choose Zero Wing as its partner and agreeing to Shi Feng's seemingly absurd demands, Hundred Flower Palace would've most likely ended up with only 10% of the Stratified Abyssal Realm's entry slots.

However, rather than feeling joyful about being praised, Cleansed Rue wore a complicated look on her face as she looked at Shi Feng.

The first time Cleansed Rue met Shi Feng was in front of the Primordial Demon Court. At the time, Shi Feng had caused her and Hundred Flower Palace to suffer a huge loss. Yet, now, Shi Feng had helped Hundred Flower Palace secure 90% of the Stratified Abyssal Realm's entry slots. She even felt an indescribable sense of reliability when she looked at Shi Feng's back right now...

Meanwhile, some distance away from Shi Feng's party, the Tower Alliance's party of six wore indescribably ugly looks on their faces.

Originally, they had entered the Sealing Labyrinth thinking that they would be securing 90% of the Stratified Abyssal Realm's entry slots. They had never thought that Hundred Flower Palace would be the one to monopolize 90% of the slots instead.

Although they had thought of forcing their way into the raid halfway through to rake in some contributions, they eventually decided against doing so. This was because there was no benefit in doing so. It wouldn't change the outcome in any way. Hundred Flower Palace could simply stop attacking the Boss and switch to annihilating them instead. After all, the agreement the Tower Alliance signed with Hundred Flower Palace did not state that they could not attack each other. They merely agreed to open the Sealing Labyrinth together and split the entry slots for the Stratified Abyssal Realm.

While the two Guilds' members were busy celebrating and sobbing, Shi Feng, who stood before the Dark Titan's corpse, wore a dumbfounded look on his face.

"I really cannot understand what Hundred Flower Palace is thinking. The entry slots might be important, but the loot of this Boss probably isn't much worse than those slots," Gentle Snow exclaimed, shock coloring her face as she looked at the items scattered across the ground.

She used to be the Guild Leader of Ouroboros, a first-rate Guild, several years ago, so she had seen the loot of Mythic Bosses on numerous occasions. She had even seen the loot of many Superior Mythic Bosses.

However, all of them paled compared to the Dark Titan's loot.

This was because the density of the Mana the dropped items carried was on an entirely different level.

In the past, the strongest item Gentle Snow had seen might have radiated dense Mana, but the Mana the item radiated remained invisible to the naked eye. However, every one of the items the Dark Titan dropped was currently radiating mist-like Mana.

How powerful must these items be for them to radiate such frightening Mana?

"This loot has indeed exceeded my expectations," Shi Feng similarly exclaimed. "If they were to see what the Dark Titan dropped, they would have also regretted agreeing to our deal."

For a Mythic monster, the Dark Titan did not drop many items. It had dropped only 32 items in total. Moreover, 30 of them were materials.

However, these were all incredibly special materials.

Abyssal Heart Fragments!

If what they got was the complete Abyssal Heart, they would've had an Inferior Divine Artifact ranked material on their hands. Even so, as the fragments of an Inferior Divine Artifact ranked material, the Abyssal Heart Fragments were still rated as Legendary materials.

When added into the production of weapons and equipment, an Abyssal Heart Fragment had a 50% chance of granting the item a Mana Amplification effect. In addition, it also had a 20% chance to upgrade a Dark-Gold item to an Epic item and a 1% chance to upgrade an Epic item to a Fragmented Legendary item.

Typically, one could exchange for a Fragmented Legendary item with just ten Abyssal Heart Fragments. This meant that the Dark Titan had dropped three Fragmented Legendary items' worth of Abyssal Heart Fragments.

It should be known that a first-rate Guild would, at most, have several dozen Fragmented Legendary items. So, three Fragmented Legendary items were still a considerable fortune for a first-rate Guild.

Not to mention, in addition to the thirty Abyssal Heart Fragments, the Dark Titan had also dropped one Fragmented Legendary item and one Primal Lineage Crystal.

[Abyssal Eye] (Ring, Fragmented Legendary Rank)

Equipment Requirement: Strength 1,500, Agility 1,200

All Attributes (Increases according to the user's level)

When equipped:

Increases all Attributes by 40%;

Reduces all hostile dark-type effects by 50%;

Ignore Levels +10

Additional Skill 1: Dark Star. Continuously cause dark damage to a radius of 500 yards for ten seconds.

Cooldown: 30 seconds.

Additional Skill 2: Abyssal Power. Grants the wearer the power of the Abyss, increasing Defense by 100%, Strength by 150%, Agility by 60%, Physique by 50%, and Endurance by 100% for three minutes.

Cooldown: 3 hours

Possession of the Abyssal Lord. Destroyed by the Eternal Spear, the Abyssal Eye's core has been split into four fragments. The Abyssal Eye will restore itself when the three other core fragments are collected. Current restoration progress (0/3)

...

Rings were much rarer than weapons and equipment in God's Domain. Typically, even the various superpowers' Tier 5 experts would only be using Epic Rings, while most Tier 4 experts would still be stuck using Dark-Gold Rings. Moreover, the level of these rings would be far beneath the players using them.

Due to their rarity, rings would typically be valued one rank higher than their actual rank. For example, a Dark-Gold Ring would be valued similarly as an Epic Equipment.

Meanwhile, the rarity of Fragmented Legendary Rings was close to rivaling the rarity of Legendary Equipment. Not to mention, the Abyssal Eye was originally a Godly Relic. So long as he could find the three remaining core fragments, he could return the ring to its former glory. Hence, its value was many times higher than the average Fragmented Legendary Ring.

However, compared to the Abyssal Eye, Shi Feng cared more about the dark crystal in his hand.

This dark crystal was none other than the Primal Lineage Crystal.

It was also an item that Shi Feng had never thought he would obtain, and its value was much higher than even the Abyssal Eye.

Chapter 161 - Primal Lifeform

There existed three ranks of Lineage Crystals in God's Domain: the normal Lineage Crystal, the higher-ranking Advanced Lineage Crystal, and the highest-ranking Primal Lineage Crystal.

Primal Lineage Crystals were the only means for players to convert into a primal lifeform. However, Primal Lineage Crystals were so rare that their rarity surpassed even Legendary items. To put it into perspective, a typical God's Domain would only have around a dozen primal lifeforms.

In terms of Life Rating, primal lifeforms did not exceed higher lifeforms such as Demidragons by much. Some primal lifeforms were even inferior to Demidragons when it came to Life Rating.

However, there was one aspect in which primal lifeforms had an insurmountable advantage over the higher lifeforms—World Affinity!

Among the many creatures in God's Domain, primal lifeforms started with the highest World Affinity.

In God's Domain, it was widely known that the higher a player's World Affinity was, the higher their affinity with Mana would be. At the same time, they would also have an easier time perceiving the operating principles of Mana.

If the average player started with one point in World Affinity, a primal lifeform would start with three points in World Affinity. Even players who had reached Level 1 World Authority wouldn't have such high World Affinity. Most importantly, the World Affinity gained through converting to a primal lifeform stacked with the World Affinity players gained through World Authority.

Moreover, the World Affinity gained this way wouldn't disappear even if players left the God's Domain they came from. This was because it wasn't a blessing granted to them by their homeworld but rather an inherent part of their strength instead.

Of course, converting to a primal lifeform wasn't an easy task. Aside from requiring a Primal Lineage Crystal, one would also need 10,000 Mana Stones to activate the Primal Lineage Crystal.

Mana Stones were much rarer than Magic Crystals. Although Master Alchemists could synthesize Mana Stones using Magic Crystals, the conversion ratio was 1:100. Moreover, the synthesis success rate wasn't 100%. In other words, it'd cost at least one million Magic Crystals to convert to a primal lifeform. It simply wasn't a cost the average person could afford.

This saves me a lot of trouble, Shi Feng thought as he put the Primal Lineage Crystal into his bag.

Originally, Shi Feng had planned on using an Advanced Lineage Crystal to increase his Life Rating. Then, he would head to the main continent and pick up an Inferior Legendary Quest to increase his World Authority in preparation for his Tier 5 promotion.

Not all Tier 6 God-ranked experts were equals. In fact, the difference in strength between God-ranked experts was much greater than even the difference between Tier 3 and Tier 4 players. If he did not pave a solid foundation for himself, even if he reached Tier 6, he would merely be an insignificant Tier 6 Godranked expert in his sub-world and the Greater God's Domain.

Shi Feng might seem very strong right now, but that was only because of a few factors, namely the Winter of Eternal Night, his Legendary Mana Body, and his superb control over Mana. In the Winter of Eternal Night's case, it was a Fragmented Legendary Weapon that closely rivaled Legendary Weapons. In the case of his Mana control, he was confident that nobody could match him in this regard at Tier 3. Even if the Tier 6 God-ranked experts on the main continent reverted to Tier 3, none of them could match him.

However, once he climbed to higher tiers, these advantages would quickly grow insignificant. If he climbed to higher tiers without increasing his advantages, the gap in strength between him and his peers would shrink continuously, and some might even surpass him.

It should be known that even the Tier 5 experts on the main continent had much greater advantages accumulated than he currently did, let alone the main continent's Tier 6 God-ranked experts. This was because every veteran Tier 5 expert on the main continent would have several Fragmented Legendary items, with some even having Legendary Weapons and Equipment. In addition, they also possessed a large number of Tier 5 Skills and Spells.

The difference between a player wielding a large number of Tier 5 Skills and a player with only one or two Tier 5 Skills was bigger than the difference between a human and a dog.

This was also why few Tier 5 and Tier 6 experts were willing to enter the Miniature Ancient World. Entering the Miniature Ancient World would mean losing all the advantages they had accumulated over the years. There wasn't even a guarantee they could accumulate as many advantages in the Miniature Ancient World as they previously had on the main continent.

Shortly after Shi Feng had sorted out the Dark Titan's loot and equipped the Abyssal Eye, the chains binding the spatial fissure started shattering one after another. At the same time, the spatial fissure's size also expanded by several times, occupying nearly half of the entire hall.

Subsequently, the spatial fissure radiated a powerful attraction force that caused everyone to subconsciously gravitate toward it. Shi Feng and the others had to resist with all their strength just to avoid getting sucked into the spatial fissure.

At the same time, a system notification rang in everyone's ears.

System: Gate of Crossing activated. The wielder of the complete key may safely teleport up to 20 people to the Stratified Abyssal Realm through the Gate of Crossing. Once used, the key will enter a Cooldown period of ten natural days to accumulate energy. The key will also be required to safely return from the Stratified Abyssal Realm. Those without the key's protection, please enter with caution.

"Why are there only twenty slots?" Rain Song couldn't help but be confused when she heard the system notification.

Crimson Heart and Cleansed Rue also couldn't help but be surprised and frown at this revelation.

According to the information they found through investigating the Dragonfall Secret Land, they discovered that the Stratified Abyssal Realm was a massive place. It was much larger than even the empires on the main continent. Although the Stratified Abyssal Realm had a strict level limit, its player population should amount to one billion at the very least. After all, aside from the countless native powers, plenty of experts from the various God's Domains also operated there.

In their opinion, the teleportation gate should accommodate a thousand players at a time, at the very least. Otherwise, how were foreign players like themselves supposed to thrive in the Stratified Abyssal Realm?

Yet, now, the system was telling them that they would only receive twenty entry slots.

After setting aside the Tower Alliance's two slots, they still had to split half of the remaining 18 slots to Zero Wing. This meant that Hundred Flower Palace would only have nine entry slots.

What could they possibly do with just nine slots?

The amount of items nine players could carry was incredibly limited. There was no way they could establish a long-term trade channel with just nine players. Not to mention, the currency used in the Stratified Abyssal Realm was different from the currencies they used.

"This is much better than we initially anticipated."

Unlike Hundred Flower Palace's members, Blood Hammer, the leader of the Tower Alliance's party, revealed an excited expression when he heard the system notification. Although they were four or five entry slots shorter than their initial expectations, the Cooldown of the Gate of Crossing here was only ten days. That was significantly better than some of the other gates with month-long Cooldowns.

If Blood Hammer were to learn that Hundred Flower Palace's members had come into the Sealing Labyrinth thinking that they could acquire 1,000 entry slots into the Stratified Abyssal Realm, he would probably laugh himself to death.

The Stratified Abyssal Realm was a special location that connected the many worlds of God's Domain.

If every God's Domain could periodically send 1,000 players into the Stratified Abyssal Realm, it wouldn't take long before the various God's Domains' players outnumbered the native players. If that were the case, the various Stratified Abyssal Realms wouldn't have remained under the absolute control of the various native powers all this time. The various God's Domains' powers wouldn't have had to try to butter up to the Stratified Abyssal Realms' native powers.

Being able to gain nine entry slots every ten days was a privilege that could make even the Greater God's Domain's various peak powers grow envious.

Chapter 162 – New Expansion Pack

Nine slots? Shi Feng was greatly surprised when he heard the system notification. It seems I'll have to make ample preparations for this.

Shi Feng possessed an in-depth understanding of the Stratified Abyssal Realm. The average Gate of Crossing could only accommodate five or six people, with larger ones accommodating up to ten people.

Yet, not only could the Gate of Crossing before them teleport up to twenty players at a time, but it only had a short Cooldown of ten days. The value of this Gate alone was several times greater than the combined value of several Tier 6 God-ranked experts.

It should be known that in addition to allowing players from God's Domain to travel to the Stratified Abyssal Realm, the Gates of Crossing also allowed players native to the Stratified Abyssal Realm to travel to God's Domain. The only difference was that the Stratified Abyssal Realm's native players needed to pay an exorbitant price in Seven Luminaries Crystals to travel to God's Domain.

According to Shi Feng's knowledge, the amount of Seven Luminaries Crystals that native players needed to pay to leave would differ depending on their combat standards. The higher a player's combat standards, the more Seven Luminaries Crystals they needed to fork out when leaving the Stratified Abyssal Realm.

Even experts at the World Tower's first-floor standard were already required to pay 1,000 units of Seven Luminaries Crystal to leave, while second-floor experts were required to pay 3,000 units.

However, 1,000 units of Seven Luminaries Crystal was a sum that a second-rate Guild would need two months to collect. Although first-rate Guilds and superpowers could collect a lot more Seven Luminaries Crystals, it simply wasn't worthwhile to do so.

Players who reached the World Tower's first floor might be recognized as experts in the Greater God's Domain, but they weren't exceptionally rare or powerful experts. They wouldn't even be considered top-ranking experts in the various first-rate Guilds.

As for second-floor experts, while they were indeed powerful combatants, the cost to teleport a second-floor expert out of the Stratified Abyssal Realm was 3,000 units of Seven Luminaries Crystal. Even a first-rate Guild could only afford to teleport one such expert out of the Stratified Abyssal Realm once every two months.

Not to mention, due to the Stratified Abyssal Realm's restrictions, native experts were at a very low level and tier. So, Guilds would have to invest a lot of time and resources to develop these experts to their full potential.

For a God's Domain that had yet to gain access to the Greater God's Domain, the Stratified Abyssal Realm's true value lay in the trade opportunities it offered.

The Stratified Abyssal Realm possessed various precious resources that weren't available in God's Domain. Even if they set aside the Stratified Abyssal Realm's unique resources, the Skills, Spells, combat techniques, and Mana Techniques the Stratified Abyssal Realm possessed were also far superior to what was available in their God's Domain.

Due to the various Stratified Abyssal Realms having a very low level cap on average, the native players there compensated for their lacking levels and tiers by developing their Skills, Spells, combat techniques, and Mana Techniques.

It was especially true when it came to the development of combat techniques and Mana Techniques. The various Stratified Abyssal Realms had far surpassed the many worlds of God's Domain and reached

an entirely different level. Moreover, different Stratified Abyssal Realms would have different civilization cultures and development paths. Because of this, the variety of combat techniques and Mana Techniques the various Stratified Abyssal Realms possessed was so large that it could astonish even the Greater God's Domain's hegemonic powers.

If an isolated God's Domain could gain access to these combat techniques and Mana Techniques, these techniques would greatly help its development.

Meanwhile, nine entry slots were already more than enough for Shi Feng to do many things in the Stratified Abyssal Realm.

Afterward, Shi Feng, Crimson Heart, and Blood Hammer agreed to meet before the Gate of Crossing two days later. Though, after factoring in the time needed to traverse the Sealing Labyrinth, they would only have one day to prepare once they returned to their respective God's Domains. The current Zero Wing was prospering greatly in the Miniature Ancient World. Although the new expansion pack had thrown a monkey wrench into Zero Wing's development plans, it wasn't so bad that the Guild would face destruction.

"It's not Zero Wing," Su Qianliu said, shaking her head. "But it isn't completely unrelated to Zero Wing, either. Specifically, something major has taken place over at the Asura Mercenary Alliance. Chief Administrator Hidden Soul and many other peak experts intend to withdraw from Asura..."
