She had never imagined that the Skill she had learned in the Titan Library would be this powerful. She had only upgraded Water Binding to Tier 1, Level 1, yet the Skill could already partially subdue a Grand Lord. If the Skill were upgraded to Tier 2, it could suppress a Grand Lord completely.

"Good. Everyone, focus your full power on the Ape King!" Shi Feng excitedly ordered after watching Fire Dance's performance with her new Skill.

In God's Domain, Skills generally fell into three categories: Attack Skills, Healing Skills, and Control Skills. However, there were also Domain Skills. However, this type of Skill was extremely rare, and players usually only discovered them after reaching Tier 4.

This was also one of the reasons that there was such a huge strength gap between Tier 3 and Tier 4 classes.

Hence, for safety's sake, after reducing the Ape King's HP to nearly 50%, he shifted the team's attention towards the Two-headed Apes. Once the two Great Lords were almost dead, they would then return to deal with the Grand Lord. However, to achieve all of this, the team's positioning and coordination needed to be precise. If the Mount a Guild captured was a 3-star Mount or below, its upgrade chances were even lower.

However, with the Beastmaster's Compendium, Guilds could craft medicine that increased the promotion success rates. Moreover, the boost was quite high. Even a Basic Beastmaster's Potion could increase the success rate of upgrading a Mount to Bronze rank by 10%, Mysterious-Iron rank by 5%, and Secret-Silver rank by 1%.

If others knew that Zero Wing possessed the Beastmaster's Compendium, every Guild in God's Domain would target them. Furthermore, to produce the Basic Beastmaster's Potion, one needed to become a Master Alchemist at the very least. Hence, they needed to keep the compendium a secret.

When title is in use, Reputation with the Holy City of Titan increased by 10%. Movement Speed and all Basic Attributes increased by 20% while within the area of Titan City.

A pity. Shi Feng could not help but sigh as he swept a glance at the nine remaining players on the team. Including himself, only four of the survivors were Zero Wing members.

The third stage of the entrance trial was different from the previous two. The system directly disqualified any players killed here and sent them out of the trial. Hence, only the survivors received this title.

Moreover, this was the reward for getting the First Kill of the Demonic Ape King. In the future, others wouldn't be able to obtain this title even if they killed the Grand Lord.

With this title, they would have a much easier time should they attempt the entrance trial again in the future.

A 20% increase in Attributes was already equivalent to a mini Berserk Skill. Excluding the effects of Skills and equipment, even MTs like Ye Wumian and Turtledove could surpass Cola if they received such a huge boost.

Even so, this was still a good outcome. The Trial's Hero title increased its user's Reputation by 10%.

In Titan City, there was nothing that could be better than this reward.

Following which, Shi Feng shifted his attention to the loot dropped by the Demonic Ape King.

As he appraised the items dropped one after another, he could not help but sigh repeatedly.

"Leader, how is it?" Aqua Rose could not help but ask curiously.

The Demonic Ape King in its complete state was definitely the most horrific Boss she had ever gone up against. Even the King of Corrosion they faced before was no comparison to it. [Life Talisman] (Necklace, Bronze Rank)

Level 40 - Level 90

Equipment Requirement: Intelligence 300, Vitality 200

Intelligence +21, Vitality +27, Endurance +22 (Level 40)

Casting Speed increased by 10%.

Healing effects increased by 15%.

Additional Passive Skill-

Light of Life: Select up to eight allies within a 30-yard radius and heal them for 30% of player's Intelligence once every 3 seconds.

Additional Active Skill-

Life Connection: Select up to five allies, connecting and sharing their HPs. Life-connected targets receive a 20% increase in healing effects.

Duration: 30 seconds

Cooldown: 5 minutes

A possession of the Life Priest Irene, the Life Talisman was made using the Stone of Life, which formed from the tears of the Goddess of Life. The Life Talisman contains immense Life Force. However, due to contamination by the power of darkness, it is greatly weakened. A large amount of Magic Crystals and

EXP is needed to purify it. Can be purified five times. (The first purification requires 200 Magic Crystals and 300,000,000 EXP)

[Crimson Moon] (Greatsword, Bronze Rank)

Level 40 – Level 100

Equipment Requirement: Strength 600, Agility 400

Attack Power +975 (Level 40)

Strength +102, Endurance +36

Ignore Levels +5

When attacking, has a 30% chance to trigger Boiling Blood, increasing Strength Attribute by 500 points for 10 seconds, and a 15% chance to cause 200% damage.

Additional Passive Skill-

Blood Domain: Within a radius of 30 yards, the presence of any creatures with less than 50% HP will increase wielder's Strength by 100%.

One of Titan City's thirty-one Holy Weapons, its strength has been greatly weakened due to battle damage. Fortunately, the Holy Weapon's core remains intact. A large amount of Magic Crystals and EXP is needed to repair it. Can be repaired five times. (The first repair requires 1,000 Magic Crystals and 500,000,000 EXP)

Everyone gasped upon reading the statistics of the items.

Both pieces of Growth-type Equipment were clearly far from ordinary, particularly the greatsword, Crimson Moon. Despite being only Bronze rank, the Strength Attribute it provided surpassed even that of Epic Weapons. Crimson Moon was an entirely Strength-oriented weapon made purely with destruction in mind.

Strength-wise, not even Shi Feng's Killing Ray could compete with Crimson Moon. Most likely, only Fire Dance's Thousand Transformations was superior to it. However, the former was a Fragmented Legendary Weapon, while the latter was currently still a Bronze Weapon.

While these two items were indeed shocking, what truly grabbed Shi Feng's attention was a dilapidated crimson crystal ball. Despite its appearance, the crystal radiated faint Divine Might. Everything in the displayed information of the item was listed as "Unknown"; the result was the same even after Shi Feng used Omniscient Eyes.

However, Shi Feng knew what exactly this crystal was.

This was no longer his first time to encounter such an item.

God Crystal!

Currently, even Bronze Mounts were extremely rare in God's Domain, not to mention Secret-Silver Mounts. The latter was most likely much more valuable than even an Epic item.

As for the Tier 3 Summoning Scroll, even Super Guilds would only have a few of these things. Its rarity was even greater than Epic items'.

As for the Tier 3 Summoning Scroll, while it was very valuable, there was no guarantee that it could help defeat a Boss or to obtain a Growth-type or Epic Equipment. At best, it could aid in team battles between Guilds or when raiding a town.

As for the Secret-Silver Mount, it wasn't nearly as valuable as the Growth-type Equipment to Zero Wing. Moreover, he had the Beastmaster's Compendium. As long as he had a sufficiently skillful Master Alchemist, it was only a matter of time before he nurtured the Guild Mount to Secret-Silver rank.

The Tier 3 Summoning Scroll held even less appeal to him.

He had the Bible of Darkness. Once he was promoted to his Tier 2 class, he could easily summon Tier 3 Demons. Even now, it was possible to summon a Tier 3 Demon with Aqua Rose's Song of Beatrice. Although this Tier 3 Demon would be weakened, they could use it as a meat shield.

After both sides finished splitting the loot, Shi Feng passed the Life Talisman to Violet Cloud.

Violet Cloud was already a powerful healer, and after equipping the necklace, her healing abilities would rise further.

Once the remaining team members had rested, Shi Feng led them up the mountain.

Although the group encountered many monsters on their way into Titan City, these monsters were no threat to Shi Feng's team. After only three hours, these players arrived at the Holy City's entrance.

Titan City's gates were 100 meters tall. The surrounding walls climbed to 300 meters. When Shi Feng's group arrived before the city's entrance, they looked like ants.

Many divine runes had been engraved into the massive steel gates. When Shi Feng stepped within 500 yards of the gates, he felt an immense pressure wash over him. It felt as if these gates were the jaws of a gigantic monster.

This meant that each Intermediate Lifestyle player would need multiple tokens to reach Advanced rank.

In the past, many people had dreamed of vacationing in Titan City. Unfortunately, very few could afford such a luxury.

Following which, the team rode an advanced horse carriage and headed for Titan City's Lifestyle Association.

There were three buildings that stood out in Titan City, and one was the Lifestyle Association's floating island. Titan City's ten saints had created this special island and suspended it above the city's western area. Players could take the floating elevator in the spire to reach the island.

When Youlan and the others saw the massive island above the 400-meter tall spire, they fell silent.

Youlan had initially assumed that the Lifestyle Association in Titan City would only be slightly better than those in kingdoms and empires' capital cities. Now, however, it would seem that there were more differences than she had thought. Calling this Lifestyle Association the 'Holy Land' for Lifestyle players was an exaggeration.

Shi Feng could not help but smile at Youlan's shock.

In the past, even Grandmaster Lifestyle players had dreamed of visiting the Holy City of Titan, and not without reason.

Upon entering the spire, Youlan immediately approached an NPC to inquire about this place.

"Hello, miss. How may I help you today?" the metal robot, which stood over three meters tall, asked from behind the front desk.

"I wish to rent a Workshop. Can you give me an introduction?" Youlan asked.

Immediately, the front desk robot began to explain the various Workshops available.

However, the NPC robot's introduction was very brief. It conveyed far less information than what Shi Feng knew. Even so, it was shocking enough the first time players heard it.

The Lifestyle Association was divided into three areas, namely the lower layer, the middle layer, and the upper layer.

The lower layer referred to the spire area. Workshops ranging from Basic to Special rank were found there. However, unlike the Workshops in other NPC cities, the Mana density in these was much higher. The Special Workshop here was even superior to the Basic Meditation Room in 3-star Shops.

Of course, its rental was very expensive.

Renting an Advanced Workshop for one day cost 10 Gold, while Special Workshops cost 25 Gold per day. This was an astronomical amount to ordinary Lifestyle players.

Meanwhile, the middle layer referred to the ordinary buildings on the floating island. The island had various Research Rooms, ranging from Basic to Advanced rank, but not limited.

Research Rooms were different from Workshops in which they stored large amounts of data that players could use to research and invent their own designs.

It was commonly known that, to reach the rank of Master, Lifestyle players needed to create their own items. Moreover, they needed to create relatively high-ranking items. This was far more difficult than producing an item from an existing design.

With these Research Room, Advanced Lifestyle players would have a much higher chance of becoming a Master Lifestyle player.

It was also precisely this reason that the Holy City of Titan had been known as the Holy Land for Lifestyle players. In the past, countless Lifestyle players had spent spend hundreds of Gold to get a slot into the Holy City. However, no Guild would be foolish enough to sell their slots. Only those top-class adventurer teams would sell entrance tokens. However, the various Guilds normally bought these tokens. Independent Lifestyle players had no hope of obtaining their own.

Of course, with such high benefits, the Research Rooms' rent wasn't cheap.

A Basic Research Room alone cost 200 Gold per day, though players of any status could rent one.

As for the Intermediate Research Rooms, each cost 500 Gold per day. Moreover, one needed to be an Honorary Citizen to rent these rooms. Furthermore, loaning the room to others was forbidden.

At Advanced rank, the Research Room cost 1,200 Gold per day. Only Titan City's nobles were allowed access to these rooms. This was one of the reasons that Shi Feng had been os desperate for the Holy City's Reputation Points. Without sufficient Reputation, he couldn't rent an Advanced Research Room regardless of how much money he had.

In reality, even without the Reputation requirement, the rental cost was enough to deter most Guilds at this stage of the game. However, if one calculated the cost carefully, they would realize how inexpensive the rooms were. If a Guild nurtured a Master Lifestyle player as a result of renting one of these extortionate Research Rooms, that player could bring the Guild far more profit than the rental costs.

Above the middle layer area was the Sacred Tower in the island's center. Only players who were major nobles in Titan City were allowed to entry the tower. As far as Shi Feng knew, the players that had access to the Sacred Tower had been as rare as a phoenix's feather in the past; most of them had been Grandmaster Lifestyle players, standing at the peak of God's Domain's Lifestyle players.

As for what the Sacred Tower contained, even Shi Feng didn't know.

As the NPC robot introduced the Lifestyle Association's various benefits, everyone, except for Shi Feng, gasped.

"NPCs are really skilled thieves!" Even Bloodsucker and White Night, people who had paid no attention to Lifestyle classes, were shocked by the Research Room's prices.

Renting an Advanced Research Room for a day cost as much as an Epic item. Even Super Guilds couldn't afford this.

Even the Workshops' rent was astonishing.

If she calculated the cost of nurturing twenty Lifestyle players, each person could spend six days in Titan City. If she allowed all twenty to use Special Workshops, the rent alone would cost 3,000 Gold. After factoring in the material costs, the total would even endanger a first-rate Guild. Furthermore, she would have to use her own money, and there was still no guarantee that all twenty players would reach Advanced rank within those six days.

It was a list of the available forging designs.

This was one of the top-ranking sets among Level 50 set equipment.

Due to the system's evolution, Level 50 had become a great divide for players. Not only could players begin class-changing to their Tier 2 classes, but equipment would also receive huge Attribute increases. Moreover, Level 50 and above monsters had significantly reduced drop-rates.

Currently, even Guild elite players strutted around in the latest Fine-Gold Equipment. However, once players reached Level 50, this would no longer be possible. Even Secret-Silver Equipment would become a luxury, much less Fine-Gold rank. As a result, Forgers' status would rise exponentially.

The Magic Light Set could be divided into three ranks: Secret-Silver, Fine-Gold, and Dark-Gold.

Titan City's Lifestyle Association sold the forging designs for all three ranks. This was a benefit that no other Lifestyle Association offered. Of course, their prices were maddeningly high.

The Secret-Silver rank forging design cost 300 Gold, the Fine-Gold design cost 900 Gold, and the Dark-Gold design cost 3,000 Gold. The Dark-Gold design cost as much as an Epic Weapon. The Magic Light Set had six set pieces. At Secret-Silver rank, forging the set needed a minimum of six Mana Stones, with each set piece requiring one. At Fine-Gold rank, the amount of required Mana Stones tripled. At the Dark-Gold rank, the cost rose to insane heights as the set required a minimum of 60 Mana Stones.

The Epic Treasure Chest that Phoenix Rain had obtained had only needed 88 Mana Stones to open. Even so, Phoenix Rain had given up on the Treasure Chest due to how much time and effort it would take to acquire 88 Mana Stones.

As for Shi Feng, even with the Philosopher's Stone, he needed to invest 50 Magic Crystals to synthesize one Mana Stone. Based on market value, each Mana Stone cost 10 Gold to produce.

Fortunately, Magic Crystals were not a problem for Shi Feng. Shi Feng only regretted that he couldn't purchase the Dark-Gold rank design.

If he could equip the plate armor classes of Zero Wing's main force with the Level 50 Dark-Gold ranked Magic Light Set, the team would be invincible.
